

### THE KNIGHTS CORNER



<u>Did you know?</u> The original Pledge of Allegiance contained no reference to God. Due in large part to the efforts of the Knights of Columbus, who, in 1951, started adding the words 'under God' at their meetings, President Eisenhower signed a resolution in 1954 adding the words 'under God' to the

pledge. In a letter to the Supreme Knight, Eisenhower said:

"We are particularly thankful for your part in the movement to have the words 'under God' added to our Pledge of Allegiance. These words will remind Americans that despite our great physical strength we must remain humble. They will help us to keep constantly in our minds and hearts the spiritual and moral principles which alone give dignity to man, and upon which our way of life is founded. For the contribution which your organization has made to this cause, we must be genuinely grateful"

For Catholics, the body has the added dignity of participating in the Sacraments during life: "Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit" (1 Corinthians 6:19). In the Creed, we profess belief in the resurrection of the body. Therefore, the Church permits cremation as long as the cremains are buried in sanctified ground. Scattering ashes is prohibited.
