At our recent council meeting, we chose five different organizations to be the recipients of your unselfish giving. This week's spotlight is on the Little Sisters of the Poor. The Little Sisters of the Poor are an international congregation of Roman Catholic women

religious founded in 1839 by Saint Jeanne Jugan. She was totally confident that as the elderly poor came to her door seeking shelter, God would provide the means to be able to feed and clothe them. In the words of Saint Jeanne Jugan, "God will help us; the work is his." The Saint Joseph's Home for the Elderly in Totowa, run by the Sisters, was dedicated in 1976 and now includes congregate living apartments for elderly persons or couples still able to live independently; residential care units for ambulatory seniors who need minimal to moderate assistance; and skilled care, which provides the total continuum of care generally reserved for Residents who require 24 hour/day skilled nursing care due to the onset of illness or disability. The St. Gabriel Knights, through your generosity, have been proud supporters of the Sisters for many years.

The Chris Stefanick "Reboot" event was a tremendous success. Co-sponsored by the St. Gabriel Knights, approximately 475 people were treated to an evening of laughter, inspiration, joy, and the love of Christ.

<u>Did you know?</u> Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day. To honor the deceased, soldiers would decorate graves of their fallen comrades with flowers, flags and wreaths. Hence Decoration Day. Although Memorial Day became its official title in the 1880s, the holiday wouldn't legally become Memorial Day until 1967.


